



Travelling to Durham / Lower Mountjoy Site

Below are some brief directions if you are travelling by car, and the same directions can apply for anyone wishing to walk from the city centre for instance.

- Durham city centre is two miles from the A1(M).
- Leave the motorway at Junction 62.
- Follow signs for Durham city centre (A690).
- From the city centre, follow the exit to New Elvet (first left across the river, signposted Coxhoe, Bowburn (A177)).
- At the third set of traffic lights the road forks. Bear right onto Church Street.
- Follow this narrow road until you reach the next set of traffic lights by the White Church café/restaurant.
- Turn left here, keeping the White Church on your left, onto Stockton Road.
- The Calman Centre is part of the Lower Mountjoy site which is along Stockton Road on your right.



Parking

If you plan on driving to Durham and would like to park on campus for the day then please email Ali Lane (a.r.lane@durham.ac.uk) by 12 pm on Monday 19th of September. Where possible a visitor pass will be obtained for you and further details provided in due course, although please note that these are limited in number. If an accessible parking bay is needed, then please could you highlight this.

Should alternative parking be needed, then there is pay and display parking along Stockton Road and the nearby surrounding streets. I believe that such parking is 60p an hour from 08:00 and is currently free after 14:00.

The Calman Learning Centre

The Calman Learning Centre is located on the Lower Mountjoy site, which is between South Road and Stockton Road. It is the building opposite the Dawson (Anthropology) building, with the large cylindrical front (see images below).
